A Meritage Celebration



50 Harvests and J. McClelland consulting winemaker Mitch Cosentino produced the first Meritage wine - 1986 The Poet - that was used for trade marking the term and released on February 22, 1988. Mitch considers the establishment of the Meritage Alliance 30 years ago as, "As a major step forward in defining both red and white Bordeaux varietal blends to the upper echelon of the market without being governed by the more restrictive varietal labeling regulations."
