COMPOSITION:

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 76%, MERLOT 17%, PETIT VERDOT 7%

WINEMAKING:

THE GRAPES IN EACH LOT WERE DE-STEMMED, FERMENTED AND AGED SEPARATELY IN FRENCH OAK BARRELS FOR 30 MONTHS.

WINE NOTES:

AROMAS OF CURRANTS, BLACK PEPPER AND FLORAL NOTES WHICH FLOW ONTO THE PALATE. BRIGHT AND BALANCED, WITH BLACK CHERRY, RHUBARB, A TOUCH OF POMEGRANATE, A POLISHED TEXTURE AND A LONG FINISH. QUITE YOUNG ON RELEASE WITH A MORE BORDEAUX-LIKE STYLE AND LONG AGING POTENTIAL.
