

## J. McClelland Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon

APPELLATION: NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION:

Cabernet Sauvignon 81%, Merlot 14%, Cabernet Franc 4%, Petit Verdot 1%

Winemaking: Vineyards in St. Helena, Yountville, the Pope Valley mountains just east of Howell Mountain and the southeastern mountains of Napa Valley provided 10 small lots that were hand harvested at optimum maturity. Each lot was individually crushed, fermented and barrel aged for 30 months prior to blending and bottling in the spring of 2022.

WINE NOTES: AROMAS OF RHUBARB, CURRANTS, SAGE AND PEPPER LEAD TO A BRIGHT, WELL BALANCED FLAVOR PROFILE MARKED BY BLACK CHERRY, POMEGRANATE AND SPICE WITH AN ESSENCE OF WALNUTS. THE LAYERS ARE COMPLEX AND FULL BODIED WITH A PLEASING FINISH AND EXCELLENT AGING POTENTIAL.
